Dec. 27 is first day for candidates to take out petition in lieu of filing fee for June 3 election

Anyone interested in running for one of the offices on the June 3 primary election ballot may take out papers for petitions in lieu of paying a filing fee beginning Friday (Dec. 27). Candidates may submit a petition containing registered voters' signature in lieu of paying the filing fee in order to run for office. Signatures submitted may cover all or a portion of the filing fee. Registered voters may sign a petition in lieu of fees for any candidate, as long as the voter is eligible to vote for that candidate. All candidates receive informational packets at the time they obtain their papers from the Registrar of Voters.

A list of state and county offices scheduled for election on June 3 is attached. The registrar's staff is available to help candidates complete the necessary paperwork and answer their questions. The petition in lieu of filing fee does not apply to candidates for County Board of Education because those candidates are not required to pay a filing fee to run for office.
