County recruiting poll workers for Nov. 4 consolidated general election

Poll workers are needed at voting locations throughout Riverside County for the Nov. 4 consolidated general election. No experience is required and training will be provided by the Registrar of Voters office. Poll workers may earn up to \$125 as precinct inspectors or \$90 as precinct officers. Poll workers must attend a special two-and-a-half hour training class to familiarize themselves with election procedures and prepare to assist voters when the polls open at 7 a.m. on Election Day. Workers in both posts also receive \$20 for attending the training class.

The Riverside County Registrar of Voters also is seeking individuals who speak proficiently in English and at least one of the following languages: Chinese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog or Vietnamese.
