## **Voters encouraged to vote in tomorrow's City of Riverside general municipal election**

Tomorrow (June 6) is Election Day for the City of Riverside municipal election. The election encompasses the city's Wards 2, 4, and 6 and is not a countywide election. It is also an all mail-ballot election, so there will be no established polling places. To find ballot drop-off locations, please go to the Registrar of Voters office website at [www.voteinfo.net](http://www.voteinfo.net) or call (951) 486-7200. You may also visit the Riverside City Clerk's website at [www.riversideca.gov](http://www.riversideca.gov) or call (951) 826-5557 for more election information. Ballot drop-off locations are open from 7 a.m. through 8 p.m.

You also may cast a ballot at the Registrar of Voters office on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. The Registrar of Voters office is located at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside.

City of Riverside voter registration is 61,016 and approximately 10,300 voters already have cast ballots for the election. To be counted, all ballots must be in the possession of the Registrar of Voters by 8 p.m. on Election Day or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day.

Registrar of Voters Rebecca Spencer encourages every eligible voter to cast a ballot in the election.
