## **Voters encouraged to vote in March 2 City of Cathedral City Special Municipal Measure Election**

Tuesday, March 2 is Election Day for residents registered to vote in the City of Cathedral City special municipal measure election. Voters will be able to cast ballots at 3 polling places. To find your assigned polling place, please go to the Registrar of Voters' website at [www.voteinfo.net](http://www.voteinfo.net) or call (951) 486-7200. Polls are open from 7 a.m. through 8 p.m. The March 2 election is not a countywide election. Registered voters in the City of Cathedral City are eligible to cast votes in this election. For questions about your eligibility to vote, contact the registrar's office at (951) 486-7200.

You may also cast a ballot in the Registrar of Voters office on Election Day between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. The Registrar of Voters office is located at 2720 Gateway Drive in Riverside.

All ballots, including vote-by-mail ballots, must be received at the Registrar of Voters Office or any polling place within the City of Cathedral City no later than the close of polls on Election Day or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day to be counted.

Registrar of Voters Rebecca Spencer encourages every eligible voter to cast a ballot in the election.
