Voters encouraged to vote in tomorrow's City of Blythe mail ballot election

Tuesday, May 5 is Election Day for residents registered to vote in the City of Blythe mail ballot election and Registrar of Voters Rebecca Spencer encourages every eligible voter to cast a ballot in the election.

The election will be conducted completely by mail, so there will be no established polling places. You may cast a ballot in the Registrar of Voters office on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. The Registrar of Voters office is located at 2720 Gateway Drive in Riverside. Please call (951) 486-7200 if you need to schedule an appointment to vote in person. Ballots also may be deposited in the vote-by-mail drop-off box located at the Blythe City Clerk's office.

All ballots must be in the possession of the Registrar of Voters Office no later than the close of polls on Election Day or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day to be counted.

The final election results will not be certified until May 21. A new law allows voters who forgot to sign their vote-by-mail return envelope to correct the missing signature within eight days after the election.

The May 5 election encompasses all of the City of Blythe and is not a countywide election. If you have any questions about your eligibility to vote, please contact the registrar's office at (951) 486-7200.
