#### What will I do as a Student Poll Worker?

- Assist with Vote Center setup
- Serve the voting public with patience, understanding, and excellent customer service
- ☆ Inform limited English speaking voters that voting documents are available in their language
- Assist with closing procedures by counting ballots and completing closing documents

#### I meet the qualifications to serve as a Student Poll Worker. Now what do I do?

- Contact your Social Studies, Civics or Language teacher and ask for a "Nomination Form" you may visit our website at <a href="www.voteinfo.net">www.voteinfo.net</a> and download a Nomination Form.
- Submit a completed Nomination Form to the Registrar of Voters office via E-mail, fax or regular mail.
- ☆ Upon selection, the Registrar of Voters will schedule Student Poll Workers to a required training class.

Riverside County's population is growing and so is the demand for interpreters at polling places on Election Day. The Registrar of Voters has a great demand for Student Poll Workers with bilingual skills in the American Sign Language (ASL), Spanish, Tagalog, Korean, Chinese (Cantonese/Mandarin) and Vietnamese language. Bilingual Student Poll Workers assist limited English proficient voters at the polls to facilitate effective participation in elections.
