LOGIC AND ACCURACY VOTING SYSTEM TESTING FOR THE JUNE 2, 2026, STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION

The County of Riverside Registrar of Voters is inviting the public and all interested parties to the logic and accuracy testing for the voting system in preparation for the upcoming June 2, 2026, Statewide Direct Primary Election.

On April 30, 2026, commencing at 10:00 a.m., the Registrar of Voters' team will conduct logic and accuracy tests, a critical step in ensuring the integrity and reliability of the voting process. The testing will involve processing ballots containing selections for every candidate or measure, followed by the tallying of results. These tests are designed to evaluate the performance of the voting system, assuring voters that their choices will be accurately recorded.

The logic and accuracy tests will be conducted by the Registrar of Voters staff to uphold election accuracy and security. Transparency is a key aspect of the election process, and the public is encouraged to attend these tests to witness firsthand the accuracy and reliability of the voting system.
